Dear Mr. Guyette:

This letter contains important information regarding your DNR permit application to install riprap on the banks of an unnamed tributary to the Shioc River along Beyer Road, in the Town of Maine, Outagamie County. Your application has reached its date of closure and is considered complete. Wisconsin law (chapters 30 and 281, Wisconsin Statutes) requires that the public be allowed an opportunity to comment on projects like yours. The next step in the individual permit review process is a Notice of Pending Application and public comment period.

The enclosed document is a "Notice of Pending Application" for your project. The Department will publish the notice on our Internet website. The 30-day period to submit written public comment and the 20-day period to request a public hearing in writing will begin on the date on which the Department first publishes the notice on our Internet website. If a public hearing is held, the period to submit written public comment will end 10 days after the date the hearing is completed.

State law requires that you publish this as a Class 1 Notice, at your expense, in Appleton Post Crescent, 306 W Washington St, PO Box 59, Appleton WI 54911-4745, legals@postcrescent.com, Phone (877) 943-0444, Fax (877) 943-0443. In addition, state law also requires that you mail a copy of the enclosed notice by U.S. Mail as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested to interested members of the public. It is recommended that you notify property owners adjacent to the right-of-way who may be impacted by the proposed work, and you may notify others at your discretion.

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Riprap

Jim Guyette, N7969 STH 187, Shiocton, WI 54170 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to install riprap on the banks of an unnamed tributary to the Shioct River. The purpose of the project is to restore the north shoulder of Beyer Road, to prevent the road from sloughing off further into the tributary, which is a matter of public safety. The project will permanently impact approximately 2,300 square feet of wetland, classified as shallow marsh. The project is located in the NW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 23, Township 24 North, Range 16 East, Town of Maine, Outagamie County.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and a public informational hearing, if requested. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 30.12(3m), Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.

Any person may submit comments and/or request a public informational hearing by emailing matthew.schaeve@wisconsin.gov or writing to Matt Schaeve, 2984 Shawano Avenue, , Green Bay, WI 54313 by U.S. mail. If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed. The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
