Dear Mr. and Mrs. Kerscher:

This letter contains important information regarding your DNR permit application to install riprap on the banks of Clark Lake in Door County. Your application has reached its date of closure and is considered complete. Wisconsin law (chapters 30 and 281, Wisconsin Statutes) requires that the public be allowed an opportunity to comment on projects like yours. The next step in the individual permit review process is a Notice of Pending Application and public comment period.

The enclosed document is a "Notice of Pending Application" for your project. The Department will publish the notice on our Internet website. The 30-day period to submit written public comment and the 20-day period to request a public hearing in writing will begin on the date on which the Department first publishes the notice on our Internet website. If a public hearing is held, the period to submit written public comment will end 10 days after the date the hearing is completed.

State law requires that you publish this as a Class 1 Notice, at your expense, in the Door County Advocate, 235 N Third Ave, PO Box 130, Sturgeon Bay, WI 54235-0130, [legals@doorcountyadvocate.com](mailto:legals@doorcountyadvocate.com), Phone (920) 431-8298, Fax (877) 943-0443

In addition, state law also requires that you mail a copy of the enclosed notice by U.S. Mail as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested to interested members of the public. The Department has determined that you must notify the parties listed below. You may notify others at your discretion.

- Town of Sevastopol Clerk
- Door County Clerk

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Riprap

Tom & Lynley Kerscher, 43938 Barletta Street, Temecula, CA 92592 have applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to install riprap on the banks of Clark Lake. The applicants propose to place random riprap along 88 feet of shoreline at 5430 and 5434 West Shore Dr.

The project is located in the NE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 4, Township 28 North, Range 27 East, Town of Sevastopol, Door County.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and a public informational hearing, if requested. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 30.12(3m), Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.

Any person may submit comments and/or request a public informational hearing by emailing [CarrieA.Webb@wisconsin.gov](mailto:CarrieA.Webb@wisconsin.gov) or writing to Carrie Webb, 2984 Shawano Ave., Green Bay, WI 54313 by U.S. mail. If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
