Before we can proceed in processing your application, state law requires that you:

- 1) Publish this as a Class 1 Notice, at your expense, in Kenosha News, 5800 7th Ave, Kenosha, WI 53140, (262) 657-1000
- 2) Obtain an affidavit from the newspaper to prove that the notice was published.

Please send me the affidavit of publication to the address listed above, by no later than *October 18, 2016*.

The Department will also publish the notice on our Internet website (<http://dnr.wi.gov/permits/water/notices.html>). The 30-day period to request a hearing in writing will begin on the date on which the Department first publishes the notice on our Internet website.

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Dam Transfer of Ownership

George Wronowski, 5136 Center Street, Lisle IL 60532, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to transfer ownership of the Lake George Dam located on the GEORGE LAKE.

The project is located in the NW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 21 E, Kenosha County.

George Wronowski, intends to sell the property on which the Lake George Dam is located to *Village of Bristol in Kenosha County*. The Department must approve the transfer of dam ownership when a specific piece of land on which a dam is physically located is transferred (ss. 710.11 and 31.14(4), Wisconsin Statutes).

The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with 1.11 and 31.185(1), 31.12, 31.14, Wisconsin Statutes, and NR 150, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed transfer.

If you object to this application and would like request a contested case hearing before an Administrative Law Judge, your objection shall specify:

- 1) Why the proposed project violates the legal standards found under Chapter 31 Wisconsin Statutes; and
- 2) That you or your representative will appear at the hearing and present information supporting your objection.

A request for a contested case hearing must be received within 30 days of publication on the Department's website.

If no objections are received which request a hearing, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing.
