## Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Water Levels and Flows Notice of Public Informational Meeting

Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners, c/o Alan Jasperson, 500 College Ave., Racine, WI 53403 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit for an order setting levels or flows on Fox River.

The project is located in the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 11, Township 3 North, Range 19 East, Village of Rochester, Racine County.

During high flow periods when the Wind Lake and/or Waterford Dams open the gates to 50% or more, the Rochester Dam will be allowed to temporarily drop below the minimum water elevation of 4.20 ft. on the gauge to a water elevation no lower than 3.36 ft. on the gauge. When the Wind Lake and Waterford Dams close their gates to less than 50%, the radial gates will then be slowly closed to restore operations to the normal water elevation and will be maintained as nearly as practical, until such a time that another high flow period arises.

The proposed change is only for modification to operation during high flows. A permanent winter drawdown is not being considered as part of this application.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 31.02(1), Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.

The Department has scheduled and will hold a public informational meeting regarding the proposed modification to the operational order for the Rochester Dam. The meeting is being held so members of the public can learn more about the proposed activity. The meeting will be held on March 14, 2017 at 2pm in the auditorium of the Racine County Ives Grove Complex located at 14200 Washington Avenue (Highway 20), Sturtevant, WI, 53177. The meeting is informational only.
