

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO AUTHORIZE SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE TO A NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN

Dairy Dreams LLC has proposed a substantial modification of its Nutrient Management Plan (NMP) to the Department of Natural Resources.

The Department will review the proposal and any information from written public comments and a public informational hearing, if requested, before making a final decision. The department will determine whether the substantial NMP modification complies with ch. NR 243, Wis. Adm. Code, and the terms and conditions of the applicants WPDES permit.

Submittal of comments or petition for public hearing must be emailed or postmarked within 14 days of the date this notice is published on the Department's internet website. Comments received within 14 days from members of the public will be used, along with other information on file, in making a final determination.

Final determinations on all proposed substantial NMP modifications **will only be provided on the Department's internet website:**

The Department may schedule a public hearing upon the petition of 5 or more persons or if it determines there is significant public interest. All petitions for a public hearing on substantial NMP modifications must include: the name, address and interest of the petitioner and reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. If a hearing is held, notice of such hearing will be provided on the Department's internet website at least 10 days prior to holding a public hearing thereon and comments must be emailed or postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

If no petition for hearing is requested by 5 or more persons, the Department may issue a final determination without a hearing.

Where designated as a reviewable action, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this substantial NMP modification.

Reasonable accommodation, including the provision of informational material in an alternative format, will be made to qualified individuals upon request.
