This is a permitted CAFO and a significant expansion is planned. We are currently working on plan reviews and a permit reissuance. They need to follow the 250 setback to reviewable structures and there could be additional setbacks required through the Jefferson County Livestock Siting process.

This is near the Lake Mills State Wildlife Area, Bean Lake, Mud Lake, and Rock Lake, wetlands and tributary streams

This is a controversial project.

Fisheries Staff:

- Are you aware of any large unmapped springs or spring complexes within one mile of the proposed well?
- If there are trout streams or ORW/ERWs within 1200 feet of the proposed well, are they correctly mapped (e.g. perennial vs. intermittent, trout stream classification)? Please inform us of errors.

DG Staff:

- Have any new municipal water supply wells been proposed, approved and/or constructed within five miles of the proposed well that are not yet on the SWAP viewer?
- Are you aware of any nearby contaminant sources (man-made or naturally occurring) that could necessitate special well construction requirements? (High capacity well reviewers will check for landfills, RR sites, and special casing areas.)

All:

- Are you aware of an ongoing or pending environmental review (pursuant to s. 1.11, Wis. Stat.) within one mile of the proposed well? If so, please respond with the contact information for the lead reviewer.
- Are there local issues that may be of significance to the high capacity well review (flood plains, other potential permits, etc.)?
